*****YPDCQ PARENT TIPS*****

1. Please check your child's backpack to see what they are bringing with them. Make sure any and all valuables are kept at home where they belong and not brought to camp. We do not want unhappy campers who may lose or misplace these items, as we are not responsible for them.
2. Proper clothing is always important, check the weather and dress them appropriately. No open toe shoes, flip flops or sandals.
